

## **Professor Cherry L Wainwright**

**Professor Emeritus, School of Pharmacy, Applied Sciences and Public Health, Robert Gordon University, Aberdeen, UK**

Professor Wainwright has a BSc (Hons) in Pharmacology (University of Aberdeen) and a PhD in Cardiovascular Pharmacology (University of Strathclyde). She spent over 20 years at Strathclyde University and moved to Robert Gordon University in Aberdeen in 2003. Here she was a Research Professor, spent 8 years as the Director of the multi-disciplinary Institute for Health & Wellbeing Research and from 2015 was the lead in Cardiometabolic Health Research and Co-Director of the Centre for Natural Products in Health.



She became Emeritus Professor in 2023. Her research has focused on mechanisms of cardiovascular pathophysiology, the identification of novel therapeutic targets and discovery of novel bioactives from plant, marine algal and food processing waste-derived sources for treatment of cardiovascular disease. Cherry has published over 100 full original articles and invited reviews, 6 book chapters and edited two books. She is currently President and Fellow of the British Pharmacological Society, Fellow of the Higher Education Academy, a member of the IUPHAR Natural Products Section Committee, and a Scientific Advisory Board member for various companies and organisations.
